He was a seventeenth century Catholic Priest and martyr, who tramped the moors of York, Yorkshire for 20 years in wind, rain, or sun and snow, to preach and to bring Mass to his people. It was a dangerous activity at that time, and for doing it Fr Postgate was ultimately put to death when he was over eighty years old. It would be lovely to see you there, perhaps bring a picnic and some folding chairs and something to protect you from the sun (God willing!).
